DESCRIPTION AND INSTRUCTIONS OF SAFE USE OF TALL BARBECUE FIREPLACE

Thank you for choosing our barbecue fireplace. The barbecue fireplace manufactured in Poland consists of two elements made of sheet metal and an ash pit; does not require special assembly. Hexagonal and octagonal tall fireplaces feature an extra openwork grate.

The rules of using the fireplace safely.

- 1. Before use, put the barbecue fireplace on an even surface (for example cobblestone) in order to prevent it from tipping over.
- 2. The fireplace should always be used in the open air, never use it in confined spaces.
- 3. Do not use petrol, spirits, oil or other flammable liquids to either start the fire or while the fire is burning.
- 4. Use only firelighters in agreement with the European Norm concerning firelighters (EN 1860-3),
- 5. The fireplace may only be used by adults, not under the influence of alcohol or other intoxicants.
- 6. Do not leave the fireplace unattended. Keep out of reach of children and pets.

Instructions of use

In order to start a fire use only deciduous-tree briquettes, wood or charcoal.

After starting the fire, the fireplace may be only be moved using protective gloves in order to avoid getting burnt.

While the fire is burning, you may add wood or other safe material to keep it burning exercising due caution.

Fireplaces equipped with openwork grate are suitable for barbecuing food.

Prior to cleaning, leave the fireplace until it is completely cool. Never poor water on hot fireplace.

Note!

While the fire is burning, the barbecue fireplace heats up and reaches high temperatures. Skin burning hazard. Do not touch the hot fireplace; use protective gloves to prevent burning.

Using the fireplace, you should always follow fire safety regulations.

Warranty

The fireplace comes with a one-year warranty commencing on the date of purchase. The warranty covers production defects and material defects and ensures the replacement of defective elements.

This warranty does not cover the cost of delivery, assembly and replacement of worn-out parts (grate, barbecue openwork grate) or other. Improper use and tampering with the fireplace shall result in voiding the warranty.
